Role of the Loreto Support Persons:

- To be available throughout the case management process to the complainant.
- To encourage and support the complainant in getting suitable help.

- To assist in gaining access to information and help.
- To represent the concerns of the complainant during the case management process.
- To assist, where appropriate, with communication between the complainant and the designated liaison person.
- To arrange, where appropriate, a meeting between the complainant and the province leader.
- To consider the wishes of the complainant in regard to a pastoral response by the church to their family.

Loreto Support Person is not:

- A counsellor for the complainant and should not act in that role.
- A spiritual guide for the complainant.

Towards Healing Counselling:

Towards Healing is a counselling and support service for survivors of institutional, clerical and religious abuse, funded by the Catholic Church. It replaces the Faoiseamh counselling service which has been in operation since 1997, and which has provided face-to-face counselling to over 4,000 persons during that time, as well as helpline support to over 15000 survivors of institutional, clerical and religious abuse.

Services provided by *Towards Healing* will be developed in consultation with representatives of survivors, and will include healing meetings, group work, practical workshops and a bridging designed to link clients to services relevant to their needs (see separate leaflet).
